**Day 2 of the Jim Larranaga Senior Elite Classic continued with high scoring and high intensity games**

MIAMI, FL. - On the second day of the Jim Larranaga Senior Elite Classic, campers started their day off at breakfast at the hotel. Once they arrived at the BankUnited Center, trainers were available for them and they took team photos with Coach Larranaga. Team practice began soon after on the courts in the Fieldhouse.

The first set of games took place between Team Duke and Team Boston College and between Team Miami and Team Maryland. Duke beat BC 74-58 in a very physical game that had 16 fouls between both teams in the first half. Miami beat Maryland 64-53, making eight three-pointers throughout the game.

In the final game before lunch, Team Virginia beat Team North Carolina 80-55 even though North Carolina went on an 8-0 run to start the game. Once this game finished, the campers headed to lunch at the Hecht/Stanford dining hall while the University of Miami basketball team held practice.

The second set of games continued in the Fieldhouse as well as the BankUnited Center. Maryland beat Boston College 60-50, giving BC their second loss of the day. Duke continued their winning streak in a high scoring game, beating North Carolina 72-67. Miami won their second game as well, beating Virginia 63-58, and finished 2-0 on the day.

After the final set of games, the campers headed back to the hotel to clean up and have cocktails at the Ritz-Carlton in Coconut Grove, Miami. Finally, they all headed to the Coach Larranaga Senior Elite Awards Dinner where the campers received awards.
